This show presents the humorist, writer, and stage personality as a white-haired 70-year-old man in a white suit and red ascot recalling his life as a boy on the Mississippi River and as a riverboat pilot, a Confederate soldier in the Civil War (for two weeks), a gold and silver prospector in Nevada, and a reporter in Virginia City and San Francisco.

Twain's own words are excerpted from his novels “The Adventures of Tom Sawyer” and “Adventures of Huckleberry Finn” as well as from his short stories, essays, speeches, letters, and autobiography. Drawing upon these well-known writings as well as his lesser-known satire, this compelling one-man show presents material used by Twain himself in his famous talks throughout the country and world. Twain's comments about Minnesota and North Dakota were made during his train trip through this area on his World Lecture Tour of 1895.
